ALIF: Journal of Comparative Poetics. 1981- Main Stack PN851.A39, electronic archive (minus the last 3 years) on JSTOR. Refereed annual with articles in Arabic, English and sometimes French. Does not publish book reviews.

Annals of Scholarship: An International Quarterly in the Humanities and Social Sciences. 1980- Main Stack H1.A6 Contains articles and book reviews.

arcadia: Internationale Zeitschrift fuer Literaturwissenschaft. 1966- Main Stack PN851.A7, electronic archive for v. 1, no. 2-v. 30, no. 3 on PCI. Furnishes a "forum for internationally comparative studies that deal with literatures and liberal arts from all parts of the world. Current theories associated with these literatures and liberal arts are discussed. arcadia includes the columns: essays, miscellanea, reviews, submitted works and news."

The Comparatist. 1977- Main Stack PN855.C66, 1998-
An annual published by North Carolina State University and the Southern Comparative Literature Association. Recent emphasis on Third World, Afro-Caribbean, and Central European literary phenomena. Publishes articles and reviews.

Comparative Critical Studies. 2004- Main Stack PN863.C667 Formed by the joining of *Comparative Criticism* and *New Comparisons*, the journal appears thrice yearly with one issue focusing on reception studies. It covers "literary theory and criticism; comparative and cultural studies; and interdisciplinary debate." Contains articles, some lectures given at BLCA, translations, discussion of translation, essay reviews.

Canadian Review of Comparative Literature/Revue canadienne de littérature comparée. 1974- Main Stack PN851.C351 Publishes articles, reviews and review essays.

Peer-reviewed quarterly published on the web. The scope is "scholarship in the widest definition of comparative literature and culture in combining comparative literature with cultural studies as 'comparative cultural studies.'" Also contains book reviews.

Compar(a)ison: An International Journal of Comparative Literature. 1992- (Continues *Comparatio*)

Semi-annual publication meant to articulate different approaches to comparative literature with the intent of letting them interact. The journal intends to "promote the theory of comparative literature and the development of new directions in comparative studies." One issue each year is has a special theme.

Comparative Literature. 1949- Main Stack PN851.C6, electronic archive (minus the last 5 years) on JSTOR. Recently designated as the official journal of the American Literature Association. Publishes articles, reviews and “welcome[s] submissions that explore important issues of literary history not confined to a single national literature or address significant problems in literary theory.”

Comparative Literature & Culture. 1997- East Asian PL2274.C431
Annual published at the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Comparative Literature Studies. 1963 (special advance issue), v. 1, 1964- Main Stack PN851.C634. v.37- available to UC through Project Muse). Publishes articles and book reviews.

Cowrie: A Chinese Journal of Comparative Literature. 1983- Main Stack PN851.C87 v. 1-4 only
Annual publication with articles in Chinese and English. Contains book reviews.

Dedalus: Revista Portuguesa de Literatura Comparada. 1991- Main PN851.D43, v. 3/4, 1992-
Annual publication with articles on comparative literary and cultural studies and book reviews.

Hikaku Bungaku. 1958- East Asia 5041.2508, v. 1-37, 1958-1994. UCLA still subscribes.
Annual in Japanese.

Forum for Modern Language Studies. 1965- Main Stack PB1.F63, some full-text in PCI, v. 37, 2002-
available to UC through Oxford Journals Online. “The journal sets out to reflect the essential pluralism of modern language and literature studies and to provide a forum for worldwide scholarly discussion. Each annual volume normally includes two thematic issues.” Contains many book reviews.

Intertexts: a Journal of Comparative Literature and Theoretical Reflection. 1997- Main Stack PN851.I58, selected full texts from 1999 in Expanded Academic. Publishes articles, bibliographies and book reviews.

Jadavpur Journal of Comparative Literature. 1961- Main Stack PN851.J2 (many in NRLF)
Includes book reviews.

Literary Research / Recherche littéraire. 1983- Some recent issues available at http://epe.lac-bac.gc.ca/100/201/300/literary_research-ef/ Semiannual publication sponsored by the International Comparative Literature Association. Publishes articles, review articles and book reviews. Features Forum, an interchange of idea.

Neohelicon: Acta Comparationis Litterarum Universarum. 1973- Main Stack PN851.N46, v. 26- available online for UC users through Springer. Established by the Hungarian Academy of Sciences and published twice a year, *Neohelicon* is a “review for studies in comparative and world literature. It particularly welcomes studies which further a synthetic presentation of literary epochs, periods, trends and movements from a comparative point of view.”

Orbis Litterarum: International Review of Literary Studies. 1943- Main Stack PN1.O7; v. 55- available online for UC users through Blackwell. A bi-monthly journal for the international and comparative study of literature. Articles, review articles.

Revue de littérature comparée. 1921- Main Stack PN851.R48, 1921-1999 available electronically through PCI. Comparative studies of modern literature and articles on theory. Includes book reviews.

Rivista Italiana di Letteratura Comparata. 1990- Annual with articles on comparative literature and book reviews.

Rivista di Letterature Moderne e Comparate. 1946- Main Stack PN5.R5 Articles on modern and comparative literature and book reviews.

Semicerchio: Rivista di poesia comparata. 1985- “*Semicerchio* focuses on poetry from the antiquity to the present with special attention to the international scenario and intercultural relationships, and to thematic criticism and the literature of migrants.” Included many book reviews.

Studies in the Humanities. 1969- Berkeley has selected articles online through Expanded Academic for 2000-2003. UC Davis has the entire run of the journal in Shields Library, AS36.I5 S78.

“Publishes studies in literature, film, drama, theory and cultural studies. The journal encourages works which are multidisciplinary and cross-cultural.” Includes book reviews.

symploke: a journal for the intermingling of literary, cultural and theoretical scholarship. 1999- Main Stack PN80.S87, v. 5 on, issues beginning with v.7 are included in Project Muse. “*symploke* is a comparative literature and theory journal. The editors' aim is to provide an arena for critical exchange between established and emerging voices in the field.” Includes book reviews as well as articles.

Tamkang Review: A Quarterly of Comparative Studies between Chinese and Foreign Literatures. 1970-

Main Stack PL2250.T3 The journal publishes “comparative studies of Chinese literature in relation to other classical and modern literatures. It also publishes studies of Chinese Literature from a critical point of view that places the subject within the context of world literature and studies dealing with theoretical aspects of East-West comparative literature.” Includes book reviews.

World Literature Today. 1927- Main Stack Z1007.B7, some articles available through Expanded Academic, LiOn and PCI. Former title: *Books Abroad*. Essays on “contemporary literary and cultural topics addressing any geographic region or language area.” Included book reviews.

Yearbook of Comparative & General Literature. 1952- Main Stack PN853.Y4 Publishes “theoretically informed research in literary studies with a comparative, intercultural, or interdisciplinary emphasis.” Includes book reviews.
