Fundamental'naia Elektronaiia Biblioteka: Russkaia Literatura i Fol'klor

Below are some hints to get the most out of this resource. Because the web site is a work in progress, some of the information below may become out of date over time. To keep abreast of developments read Novosti which is provided on the site's home page.

The bulk of the texts and scholarly apparatus can be found through the links on the left side of the page under Literatura i fol'klor marked as Deistvuiushchie izdaniia. By clicking any of the authors or works cited, one is taken to a page which will contain literary works by the author along with a wealth of bibliographic and biographic information. Literary texts are fully documented as to the source of the material and are fully searchable if one's browser has Cyrillic keyboard capabilities. The scholarly apparatus includes full texts of the articles and gives full references to the sources.

Under Spavochnye razdely, again in the section marked Deistvuiushchie izdaniia, the 11 volume *Literaturnaia entsiklopedia* published in Moscow from 1929-1939 is present in its full form. I have also requested a link directly to this reference tool through the entry for it in our Library's on-line catalog. The link to Personalia provides biographies and bibliographies of several prominent Russian philologists. Though incomplete, Izvestiia AN provides tables of contents to many of the volumes of this important serial.

Finally, under Ukazateli one can find a listing of all of the scholarship that has been provided either by author or by the title of the work.
