



2005 Institute Evaluation Summary

VALUE of the Institute Sessions

All 2005 Fellows ranked all of the Institute sessions as valuable (3), very valuable (4), or extremely valuable (5)

The sessions ranked most highly with respect to their value to the Fellows were:

- 5 Students and Library Research
- 5 Assignment Incubator
- 4.5 Crafting Assignments
- 4.5 Undergraduates as Learners
- 4.5 Next Steps for Implementation

All of the remaining sessions were rated either 3 (valuable) or 4 (very valuable) by the Fellows.

SATISFACTION with the Institute Sessions

The Fellows reported being either very satisfied (4) or extremely satisfied (5) with 13 of the 21 sessions.

The sessions ranked most highly with respect to satisfaction with the session were:

- 4.5 Students and Library Research
- 4.5 Connecting to Library Resources
