PRINT-AT-HOME INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 After downloading this file to your computer, print Page 1 on a piece of cardstock paper.
- 2 If you'd like to print the interior of the card, first determine the direction of your printer's paper feed.
- 3 To print the interior, place the cardstock back in the paper tray, flipped to print on the opposite side.
- 4 Now print Page 2 on the backside of your cardstock paper.
- 5 Cut out the card along the dashed lines and fold in the center.
- 6 Personalize your card, place in an A6 envelope (4" x 6"), and be sure to add a postage stamp before you mail!
