PCC has announced not immediately implementing new RDA Toolkit. LC is not training in MARC but plan to for BIBRAME. Policy statements not as extensive, no examples as before. Metadata Guidance Documents needed. Deadline was Oct 22nd so in post-processing stage. Extensive updates to be expected, published by end of calendar year, testing early next year. Adam is chair of PCC training task group for RDA, working on introductory training. Goal is to finish draft of module training, publish Feb/March 2022. Co-chair of PCC RDA Communications Committee, feedback from community, form is live. Training committee has 5 members and 1 consultant; communications committee 8 members. New RDA is better positioned to move to linked data.

 - example:Ensure the alignment of shared cataloging and metadata standards, policies, and procedures affecting our ILS, future SILS environment, discovery platforms and other appropriate finding aids maintained by the Library
 - Alignment of metadata field practices
 - LCSH- EDI (equity, diversity, inclusion) and subject headings (japanese americans forced removal and internment); racism and subject headings
 - LCSH and EDI-Classification and related subject headings- process to suggest changes, once changes are made how do we apply changes to existing records, what can we do locally
