- Ordering in Gobi, with some caveats (e.g. maybe not with Harrassowitz or Amalivre [Jo Anne will look into]).

- End of year funding origins
 - o End of FY2020-21 Acquisitions
 - a. Closeout is a little earlier this year than usual due to the Alma migration.
 - b. It's a misperception that money is taken from the selectors. Not true!
 - c. The top of the budget comes from Central Funds.
 - d. There's about \$500,000 for end-of-year purchasing.
 - e. Principles to focus on:
 - Multidisciplinary resources.
 - Various diversity material.
 - SF Chronicle archive.
 - Desiderata from division heads.
 - f. There's a \$2.2 million loss in the budget this year. Jeff M.M. will probably make up for it with the staffing budget.
