- Check-in around the table — L. Weber and S. Ismail are fantastically upbeat. Everyone else is fine/as well as can be expected.
- LibCal Seats update — L. Weber: Jennifer Dörner is leading the charge to get a tool online to reserve seats in Moffitt Library as study spaces are made available in the near future. Trial is available until Jan. 19. Awaiting status update. Security, facilities, etc. will also be involved in the process. We may have to change the website to add a link to the service: "Reserve a study seat" or similar, when the time comes.

S. Ismail noted that Beth Dupuis is leading coordination access to Moffitt study spaces with other departments, etc. and will likely talk about this at the Town Hall.

SILS Update - L. Grigsby

Numerous SILS groups are busy catching up on preparatory work. Mid-February will see another uptick in campus engagement. Training begins in early March. A survey about the proposed name has been distributed via email; please add your thoughts. Soon there will be increasing campus-wide outreach. Primo will replace OskiCat, Start Your Search and Melvyl, and will impact the Library main site, Digital Collections, and other sites. Affiliated libraries will be engaged soon. SILS will start spawning multiple projects in the next few months. We may ask Lisa Ngo and Jackie Gosselar to give us some further insight and updates at a future meeting. Other WAG members are involved and can also provide updates.

Action Items based on [WAG's Charge](#)

- Community Outreach for Redesign Project — J. Loesberg: User personas phase is complete. Sharing of those results will happen in the next month or so. We are now looking at navigational and site architecture. "Tree testing" of users is happening now to assess users' ability to access commonly sought links.
- DEI issues — Nothing at this time, but please keep this top of mind when reviewing websites in the future.
