SILS Update - July 27 Implementation

- Salwa reported that the test instances of Alma and Primo VE were delivered on time. Training has started. The Primo VE test instance still needs to be configured. The basic look and feel of Primo VE are the same across institutions. Limited customization is possible. Salwa encouraged WAG members to try Primo VE instances at other campuses such as [Cal State East Bay](#) and [UC Irvine](#)
ACTION: Salwa will find out from Jackie G. and Lisa N. when the test instance of Primo VE will be available to WAG for review.
- David showed WAG the UC Library Search wordmark. Corliss will let us know when it's ok to add it to LibGuides, blog posts, emails, etc.

Library Website Redesign - January 2022 Implementation

- Wireframes will be delivered to WAG and the other content review groups in April. A wireframe is a basic visual schematic that shows website intention; it does not include final design elements. WAG has been charged to review the navigation menu (page switcher at top of the main menu) and the list of libraries. Joe reported that the affiliated libraries are satisfied with WAG's role in the process. Jesse reported that it is likely that affiliated libraries and University libraries will be listed together as they are now.
- Gigi shared that the Library Development Office (LDO) is interested in where a link to "Give" will be located on the website. Donors are also patrons so LDO wants to make sure that potential and returning donors find the site usable and welcoming. The About page is also important to LDO as it could explain the difference between Affiliated and University libraries, which is a question often asked by donors.
- Salwa mentioned that Tiffany recently presented the UX firm's (ADK) findings to Roundtable and reminded WAG members to solicit feedback from their constituencies and especially from supervisors and AULs.
